





# What is a street pastor?

Street Pastors are trained volunteers from the local churches. They give up their time to help people in towns and cities who might need assistance at some point in the evening.

They wear high visibility jackets and carry rucksacks containing their kit, and provide a range of assistance. For example, tending to grazed knees, finding taxis to get people home safely if they have lost their friends or have become disorientated, providing slippers where shoes have been lost or broken, and offering genuine kindness and support to everyone and anyone who needs it. They spot the lost and lonely and distressed; they listen to them, comfort them and help them.

The team patrols the streets in the evenings, usually at the weekends, and visit pubs, nightclubs etc.

We do it because we care about people.

We make a difference to the safety and well-being of individuals in our own communities.

Our team includes the street pastors, supporters, fund-raisers, street pastor's buddies, and those who pray for us.

We have links with many local churches, e.g. BCNC (North Parish), St Serf's and Trinity and Kelty Kirk, the Salvation Army, Kelty Evangelical Church, St Finians Church, and the Baptist Churches.
